2. Pitch Legacy	DMcE reported on mixed news re the Pitch. The report details no spare budget however upon scrutiny he believes higher costs have been allocated and there may be monies available to reallocate to the pitch funding.  The feasibility study will not cost as much due to a current study being carried out on another pitch, we can use this as a starting point.  Once the tender is agreed he will be in a better position to advise. This should be between now and the end of term however DMcE will obtain this information and forward to the group.  Once we are in a better position with this funding we can then look at other organisation which may be able to contribute such as Lottery and Sports Scotland.
